

ANNUAL GATHERING OF THE FRIENDS OF SCOUTING IN EUROPE NOTES

13 October 2013, ZTS Gozdna Šola, Slovenia

1. Opening

Jörgen Rasmussen, Chairman of the European Scout Foundation, opened the meeting and welcomed all the 43 Friends of Scouting in Europe present to the Annual Gathering.

Jernej Stritih, President of the National Scout Organization of Slovenia (ZTS) welcomed the FOSE to Slovenia and to the "Forest School", the starting place of Scouting in Slovenia.

2. Message from the Chairman of the European Scout Committee

The message from Andrea Demarmels, new Chairman of the European Scout Committee was read.

3. Report of the activities in the past year

Jörgen highlighted the good financial results of the past year, despite the continued economically difficult times. In line with the usual transparency practice, the annual accounts will be circulated to all Friends once they have been audited.

He highlighted the close cooperation with the European Scout Committee, which is essential for the impact of the Friends of Scouting in Europe. He thanked all FOSE for their continued support and donations, both in the form of FOSE payments and the support to Small Projects.

4. Report of the results of last year's annual meeting

René Karla presented the results of last year's FOSE Annual Meeting in Bosnia-Hercegovina. The meeting had generated a surplus which, together with two donations from individuals, was invested in three projects presented by the Bosnian Scouts. All three projects had been successful. The report of the Scouts of Zenica was received with thanks. The reports of the two remaining projects will be shared with the Friends as soon as they are received.

5. Financial report

Walter Hofstetter, Treasurer, presented the financial situation of the Foundation. The financial year has just ended on 30 September 2013 and the annual accounts are now being prepared. The year has been positive due to the recovery trend in the stock markets.

In addition to its own funds, the Foundation has been managing also the European Region's European Investment Fund and the European Leadership Training Fund which supports Leader Training projects between Eastern and Western Europe.

Walter reported that at the end of the financial year, there were 13 new Life Friends for a total of 145. There were 296 Annual Friends for a total of 441 FOSE.

6. Small Projects

Jörgen reported on the Small Projects, which are intended to support Scouting activities in the local level. The reporting has been strengthened with the support of Nils-Georg Troels-Smith.

The Slovenian Scouts presented a Small Project concerning training of young spokespeople and improving the educational image of Scouting.

During a test period of the next 18 months, Small Projects will be accepted not only from Central and Eastern Europe but also from other European countries which are experiencing the financial crisis. Project proposals will be published on the website of the Foundation www.europeanscoutfoundation.org

7. Time and place of next Annual Gathering

An invitation has been received for the next year's Annual Gathering to be held in Vilnius, Lithuania on 9-12 October 2014. Lene and Peter have agreed to again organise the programme of the weekend. The invitation to meet in Lithuania was accepted with acclamation.

8. Other upcoming FOSE gatherings

The next FOSE gathering in **Belgium** will take place on Friday 1 November 2013 in conjunction with the Academy organised by the European Scout Region. Gathering in **Germany** will take place on Sunday 3 November 2013 at the Tydal Scout Centre in South Slesvig.

9. Any Other Business

There was none.

10. Close of the meeting

Jörgen Rasmussen closed the meeting and thanked all the participants. He especially thanked the Slovenian hosts for welcoming FOSE in Slovenia and Lene and Peter for the excellent organisation of the weekend.
